AI Hiring Bias Laws Limited by Lack of Transparency in Tools

The Colorado and Illinois laws require employers to notify job candidates and employees when using AI for hiring. But they don't go into force until 2026 and are subject to state agency rulemaking first.

"The devil's in the details," said Tracey E. Diamond, an employment attorney with Troutman Pepper Hamilton Sanders LLP. When employers are "buying a third-party tool, how much insight do they have into the inner machinations?"
