David S. Kupetz, a partner in the Los Angeles office of Troutman Pepper Locke, told *Law360* he is involved in dozens of ABC cases operating under California's common law doctrine for such proceedings that does not require court supervision, adding that the system is operating with a high level of efficiency.

"There's a very high velocity of new matters," Kupetz said. "It's a very active area, and they're working extremely well."

He said the Uniform Act is a well-intentioned effort to standardize ABCs nationwide, but that in his view, the current system is working well.

"I'm not against the Uniform Act, but I also am not experiencing any problems in the ABCs that I'm involved in," he said.
