Alison Grounds, founder and managing partner of Troutman eMerge, will speak on the panel “Best Practices for AI Review and Production of Voluminous ESI” as part of the International Association of Defense Counsel 2026 Midyear Meeting. She will be joined by Cristin Traylor of Relativity, Ronald J. White of the Illinois Farm Bureau, and William J. Kelly III of Kelly Law Partners, LLC.
