Beyond Borders: COVID-19 Highlights the Potential Widespread Impact of the Illinois Biometric Information Privacy Act

Because of the rush to go remote, employers "may not have considered the legal risks associated with data collection and analytics as thoroughly as they would have under normal circumstances," the authors note.
