First Solar and Jarden "should give everybody pause about trying to make overbroad predictions about whether a particular court is always going to be favorable for policyholders or the insurer," said Jennifer Mathis, a partner at Troutman Pepper who represents carriers.

The rulings "demonstrate the dangers of being overly confident about how you think a court might come out on an insurance coverage issue just because it has in recent years ruled in favor of policyholders more often than carriers," she said.
