# Foreign Inverter Crackdown Threatens to Slow US Battery Storage Boom

The ban may not have immediate impacts, as it is “prospective; it’s not retroactive,” said Daniel Anziska, an attorney working on energy supply chain issues for law firm Troutman Pepper Locke.

“There isn’t an edict to ban existing inverters, rip them out, and replace them,” he told *Recharge*.

These “complexities will lead inevitably to equipment bottlenecking and strategising, [and are] basically inflationary,” Anziska said.

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
