Dave Navetta, a partner in Troutman Pepper Locke's Privacy + Cyber practice group, was quoted in the December 24, 2025 *Privacy Daily* article, "[Kids Privacy Will Remain Bipartisan Focus in 2026; Federal Law Doubtful](#)."

Similarly, Troutman lawyer Dave Navetta said he has "no faith in ... the federal process" at the moment.
