SCOTUS Ruling on Nationwide Injunctions Could Have Lasting Implications

Ashley L. Taylor, Jr., a partner in Troutman Pepper Locke's Regulatory Investigations, Strategy, and Enforcement Practice Group, was quoted in the July 7, 2025 *InsuranceNewsNet* article, "[SCOTUS Ruling on Nationwide Injunctions Could Have Lasting Implications](#)."

According to one source cited by the SCOTUS, 75 percent of all universal injunctions occurred during the past 25 years, noted Ashley L. Taylor, Jr., partner at the law firm Troutman Pepper Locke.

"What's been increasingly common is for groups of states of one political persuasion to sue presidents of the other political persuasion," Taylor added. "Although the Court does not end that practice, any injunctions would run only to those states."
