This program engages mid- and upper-level associates about how to work with junior colleagues in the editing process and produce the best possible work product for clients. Topics include (i) Giving Feedback That Encourages the Best Possible Working Relationship, (ii) Editing to Improve Writing Style, and (iii) Editing to Make an Argument More Persuasive.

The Art of Effective Transactional Drafting (Associates)

This program features four content blocks that engage junior associates in team challenges that teach core transactional drafting skills including i) protecting your client by clarifying rights, responsibilities, and duties; (ii) avoiding ambiguity in drafting; (iii) defining contract terms to protect your client; and (iv) drafting a negotiated settlement to end litigation and achieve closure for your client.
