What's Next for Financial Services Companies, Consumers and the CFPB

Ruling that the CFPB's independent funding structure is unconstitutional and striking down the CFPB's 2017 Payday Lending Rule, the Fifth Circuit's decision has far-reaching implications, raising questions about the Payday Rule, challenges to the CFPB's regulatory authority, the status of ongoing enforcement actions, and the very existence of the CFPB.
