Trauma Informed Lawyering: Learn how to work with professionalism, empathy and understanding while representing trauma survivors. Hosted by a co-founder of Villanova Law's Institute to Address Commercial Sexual Exploitation (*i.e.* human trafficking), this CLE will incorporate lessons and examples from their advocacy for trafficking survivors.

The Villanova Institute to Address Commercial and Sexual Exploitation works with those responding to sexual exploitation in the United States and beyond. They provide victim-centered, trauma-informed multidisciplinary collaboration. Troutman Pepper has already begun working with the CSE institute to represent victims of sex trafficking.
