ATLANTA – Troutman Pepper was part of a national trial team that secured a defense verdict in a jury trial involving the Pinnacle hip implant in the Southern District of Alabama. The case, *Ahmed v. Johnson & Johnson Health Care Systems, Inc. et al.*, is the first DePuy Pinnacle trial since the completion of the multidistrict litigation (MDL).
