Troutman Pepper Locke's Amicus Brief Cited by U.S. Supreme Court in Key Decision on EPA's Wastewater Discharge Rules

NEW YORK – Troutman Pepper Locke's amicus curiae brief on behalf of a large coalition of trade organizations has contributed to a decision by the U.S. Supreme Court in *City & County of San Francisco v. Environmental Protection Agency*, a major case under the Clean Water Act. In that decision, the Court held that the EPA does not have the authority to impose conditions that make the permittee liable for "crushing penalties" based on the ultimate quality of the water body into which it discharges, while quoting the amicus brief to support its reasoning.
