Trump's Attempts to Fire Lisa Cook Expose Mortgage Data Privacy Concerns

"It's not an easy, simple idea about what's public and not public relating to land ownership or mortgages, because there's no federal standard for this," said James Shreve, a partner at **Troutman Pepper Locke** specializing in data privacy, noting that some jurisdictions still list Social Security numbers in filings.

"Fannie and Freddie operate in a bit of a gray area, because usually there are privacy laws that apply to government entities and to private entities — and Fannie and Freddie are kind of between," Shreve said.
