

A former trial attorney with the U.S. Department of Justice, Antitrust Division, Bryan serves as regional and national litigation counsel to clients in courts across more than 30 states, Canada, and the EU, as well as before various administrative tribunals, such as the International Trade Commission (ITC). He assists clients ranging from startups to multinational manufacturers in patent enforcement, international patent portfolio development, and compliance with U.S. and international trade laws. Bryan has extensive experience in both prosecuting and defending high-stakes intellectual property and competition cases.
