OVERVIEW

Laura also assists clients with employee benefit plan controversy and correction issues, including voluntary corrections for retirement plans and non-qualified deferred compensation plans, defending audits by the IRS and DOL related to retirement or welfare plans, and ERISA litigation.

As an IAPP Certified Information Privacy Professional/United States (CIPP/US), Laura provides clients with guidance on privacy and cybersecurity-related issues under applicable federal and state laws, including developing and implementing comprehensive policies, incident response plans, and drafting and negotiating vendor contracts. She also assists clients with responding to data breaches by conducting the required legal and regulatory analysis, preparing required notifications to affected individuals and various governmental agencies, responding to follow-up inquiries from regulators, and coordinating responses to customers, law enforcement, regulators, and the public.
