



### OVERVIEW

Paul brings more than 20 years of experience representing aviation companies from North America and Europe in complex litigation. He serves as lead national product liability defense counsel for several of the world's largest aircraft manufacturers and their U.S. affiliates. Paul defends against wrongful death, personal injury, and commercial claims in state and federal courts across the U.S. He guides foreign and domestic corporations through all stages of dispute resolution, including mediation, trial, and appeal.

Paul's practice focuses on intricate issues related to aircraft and component design, manufacturing, and regulatory compliance. He defends many high-stakes cases, including obtaining a defense verdict following a trial in New York that set the state's record for the highest damages awarded (against co-defendants) for a single wrongful death.

Paul has a thorough understanding of multistate, national, and international laws, which is crucial for resolving disputes involving aviation accidents.

- Provided defense, including pre-trial resolution, of high-damage potential claims against a German helicopter manufacturer in connection with a widely publicized helicopter accident in Arizona involving a wealthy high-profile businessman and his family.

- Part of a team that obtained a unanimous decision from the U.S. Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals resulting in a published opinion that affirmed the summary judgment dismissal by the U.S. Northern District of Texas of a multimillion-dollar contribution claim brought against U.S. and European aircraft companies stemming from a helicopter accident in Hawaii — *Nat'l Union Fire Ins. Co. v. Am. Eurocopter Corp.*, 692 F. 3d 405 (5th Cir. 2012).
