

July 2010: Congress passes the Dodd-Frank Act, directing the SEC to implement rules under which the exchanges must prohibit the listing of July 2015: SEC publishes companies that don't adopt, comply proposed clawback rules. with, and disclose a clawback policy. October 2021: SEC reopens comment period for proposed clawback rules. June 2022: SEC again reopens comment period for proposed clawback rules. October 2022: SEC adopts final clawback rules. November 2022: Clawback rules published in Federal Register. February 2023: NYSE/NASDAQ file proposed clawback listing standards. April 2023: SEC notifies the exchanges of its intent to take action on their proposed listing standards by June 11, 2023. June 11, 2023: Deadline for SEC to approve or disapprove the proposed listing standards, unless further delayed. August 10, 2023: Projected deadline for companies to adopt compliant policies.
